Question and Responses

1. **Question:** Since the agreement references California prevailing wage laws for applicable “public works” and “maintenance” projects, can you please confirm whether this janitorial/cleaning contract will be classified as prevailing wage work?

Response: Routine office cleaning services that are not connected to a public works project, such as this RFP, are generally not considered public works and therefore are not typically subject to prevailing wage requirements. That said, prevailing wage language is included in all our standard contracts because laws and interpretations can change, and because the responsibility for determining and complying with any applicable prevailing wage requirements ultimately rests with the contractor. Accordingly, bidders should make their own independent compliance determination.
